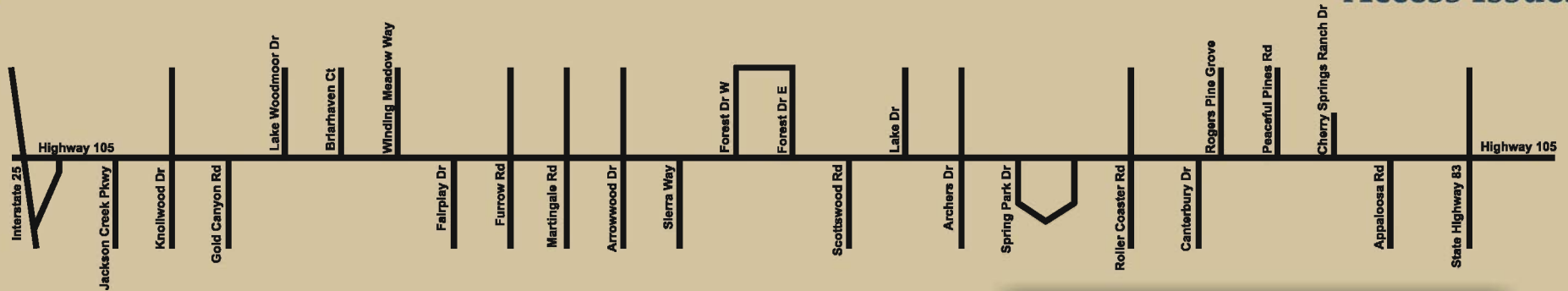




Access Issues



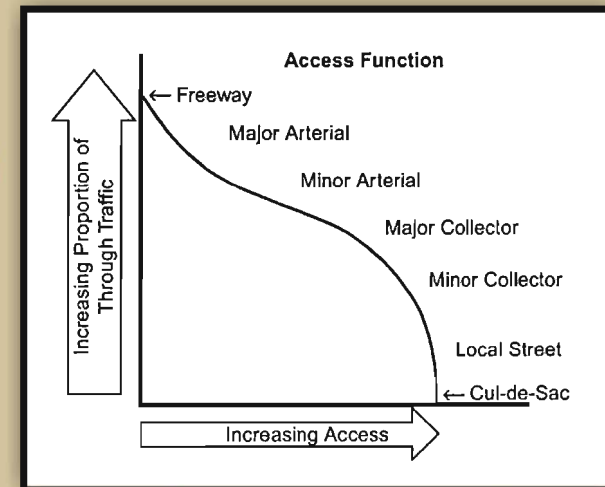
Access Management Principals

- Provide a roadway function/access hierarchy
- Limit direct access to major roadways based on spacing criteria
- Remove turning vehicles from through-traffic lanes (provide turn bays)
- Limit the number of conflict points and separate conflict areas

How can access management benefit the Highway 105 Corridor?

Managed Access:

- Preserves arterial functionality and future capacity
- Increases corridor safety
- Reduces traffic congestion
- Extends the life of the facility
- Improves the appearance and quality of the corridor
